# Important Show and Sale Details

Friday night set up is 6 to 9. Pizza and salad will be served!

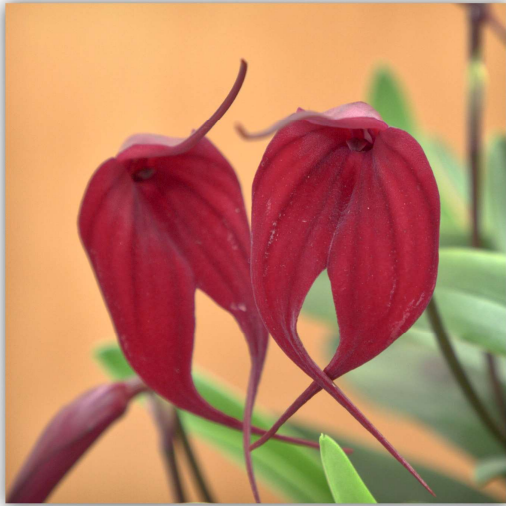
1. The show is open to any person wishing to exhibit for ribbon judging and AOS judging.
2. All Plants to be displayed in competition shall have been grown by the exhibitor or in their possession for at least 90 days prior to the show.
3. All plants must be checked in by the entry clerks. **Come with names and category notes so you can fill out the entry forms available at the show.** All entry cards should show the name of the plant or the parentage.
4. Judges may transfer plants to other classes at their discretion. The decision of the judges is final. For any questions not pertaining to judging, the decision of the show chairperson will govern.
5. For your protection and the protection of other growers, **no plant with visible insects, pests or disease will be accepted for entry.** Any plant(s) infected with insects or disease will be removed from the show. Please help prevent the spread of pests by entering only clean, healthy plants. Plants shall be in good, presentable condition.
6. No exhibitor's plant shall be removed before the end of the show, except when the life of the plant is in danger, and only with the permission of the show chairperson. All entries must be claimed promptly at 4:30 pm on the day of the show.
7. **All entries are to be received on Friday February 7 from 6pm – 9pm, the evening before the show**
8. The society will endeavor to care for all exhibits however the society can assume no responsibility for loss or injury. Containers should be inconspicuously labeled with the owner's name.

Members who wish to sell plants at the show need to see Liz Charlton for the sales paperwork.
