#### Orchid Friends:

Wow. It's February already and our Show and Sale is only about 2 weeks away (on Saturday Feb. 11<sup>th</sup>, with setup the evening before)! See the article in <u>last month's newsletter</u>, as well as elsewhere this edition for further details Putting on these events "takes a village" and I encourage all our members to step up and volunteer to help, as well as bring their blooming plants for display and judging. Eileen Jackson deserves our thanks for having done a great job organizing and rounding up vendors and AOS judges. The actual execution is up to all of us!

Note that all plants to be displayed must arrive at the Show venue (First Lutheran Church, 4000 Concord Blvd. in Concord) the night before the show. We will discuss We will also have a members' sales table. If you have plants you wish to sell, and have not already been in contact with Liz Charlton (<a href="ko6xp51@gmail.com">ko6xp51@gmail.com</a>) immediately for instructions. DVOS will take a 20% cut of all members' sales. We will also have Marcia's jam for sale. All proceeds from the jam sales will go to DVOS.

Traditionally, our annual Show has been our primary means of attracting new members. We've not held a Show since 2020, just before COVID-19 shut everything down. Our membership ranks have declined since then and it's vital for the health of our Society to bring our numbers back up. We're a volunteer organization and we can't continue to rely on the same small group to get things done. Please get the word out to your friends and acquaintances. Post on social media. 
• Set up - We will need help getting plants entered and put in the right position. No expertise necessary.


